DIRECTIONS

Approaching Newquay from the A30: At Indian Queens on the dual carriageway take the slip road on the left sign posted to Newquay. On the roundabout take the third exit on to the A39, continue for 1 mile. At the next roundabout take the third exit on to the A39 sign posted Wadebridge, continue for almost 2 miles. At the next roundabout - take the first exit on to the A3059 sign posted Newquay. After 2 miles take the turning on the right, signposted to Newquay airport and Mawgan Porth. You will pass the entrance to the Airport on your left, continue on this road and you will come to a T junction - take the right turning which leads to the B3276 coast road heading North. You will drive down to Mawgan Porth, over the narrow bridge, go past the beach and up the hill and you will come to a hairpin bend to the left with a turning on the right signposted St Eval, take this turning and 500 yards along this road on the you will see the sign for Merlin Farm. Continue SLOWLY down this private lane (keep to the left when lane splits into two). When you see a wooden sign in front of you saying 'Welcome to Merlin Farm' park on the tarmac area immediately on your left before the sign. The entrance to Blue Haze is in the far corner - it is quite hidden.

DEPARTURE PROCEDURE

Please depart no later than 10am.

The current Government advice is that used linen represent a potential hazard to cleaning staff. I am therefore asking for your help to minimise the risk to myself by stripping your bed linen and placing in the linen bag (provided in your wardrobe) and place outside.

Please remove everything you have brought with you (I.e food and toiletries) and take out all rubbish and put in the bin outside.

Please clean the BBQ after use and leave the accommodation as clean and tidy as possible. Please open the windows and leave the key in the outside of the door on departure

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

GAS FIRE IN THE LOUNGE

The fire has an integral ignition system which will light the pilot and main burner flame on initial lighting.

Ensure that the gas valve is in the off position as indicated in the diagram.


1. Depress the gas control knob and turn anticlockwise rapidly (Two Clicks will be heard). The fire should now be lit. The main burner and pilot can be viewed via the small round hole in the chrome trim just in front of the radiants. WARNING: do not get too close to the fire.

2. After rotating the control knob hold in the depressed position for approximately 10 seconds this will allow the thermocouple safety device to operate.

3. Once lit the fire control can be turned anti-clockwise to full heat or any position between low and high for the desired output.

If the fire fails to ignite on the first attempt repeat the procedure in rapid succession 3 times. If the fire has not lit after 3 attempts leave for 5 minutes and repeat steps 1 to 3.

In some cases the fire may need several attempts to ignite if the gas supply has recently been replaced.



COOKER

<u>Hob:</u>

Push and turn the control knob.

Turn the control knob anticlockwise to the full rate position.

Press the ignition button. Keep the controller pressed for about 10 to 15 seconds and then release it. Adjust the height of the flame.

<u>Grill:</u>

Open the door and push the control knob. Continue pressing the control knob and turn it anti-clockwise to the full rate position.

Push the ignition button.

Keep the control knob pressed for about 10 to 15 seconds and then release it.

Adjust the required heat setting.

The grill door must remain open when lighting and using the grill.

<u>Oven:</u>

Open the door and push in the control knob. Continue pressing the knob and turn it anticlockwise to the full rate position. Push the ignition button. Keep the control knob pressed for about 10 to 15 seconds and then release it. Adjust the required heat setting. Placed the oven shelf in the required position and close the door. Ignition must always be carried out with the oven door open. Although the oven heats up quickly a 10 minute pre-heat Is recommended. The oven should reach full temperature in about 15 to 20 minutes.
